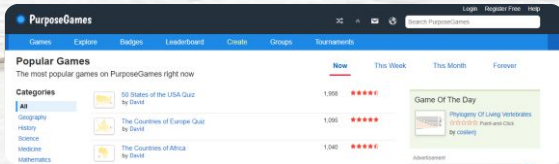

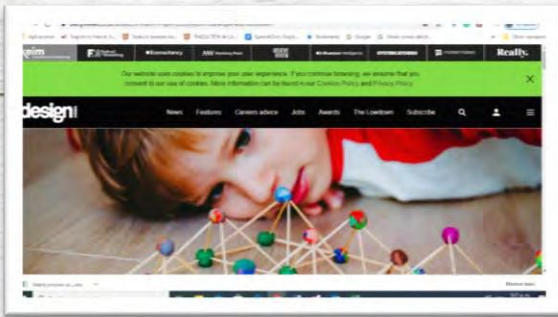
Games:

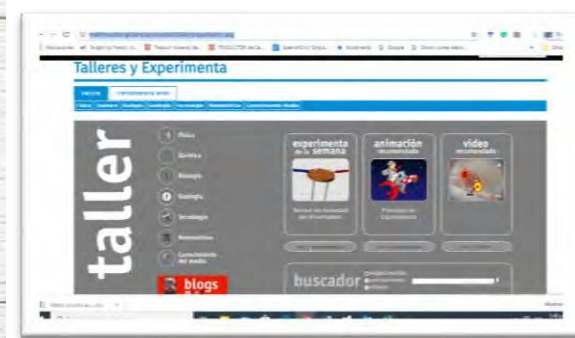
Students can use all their creativity making own toys. Challenges for all.



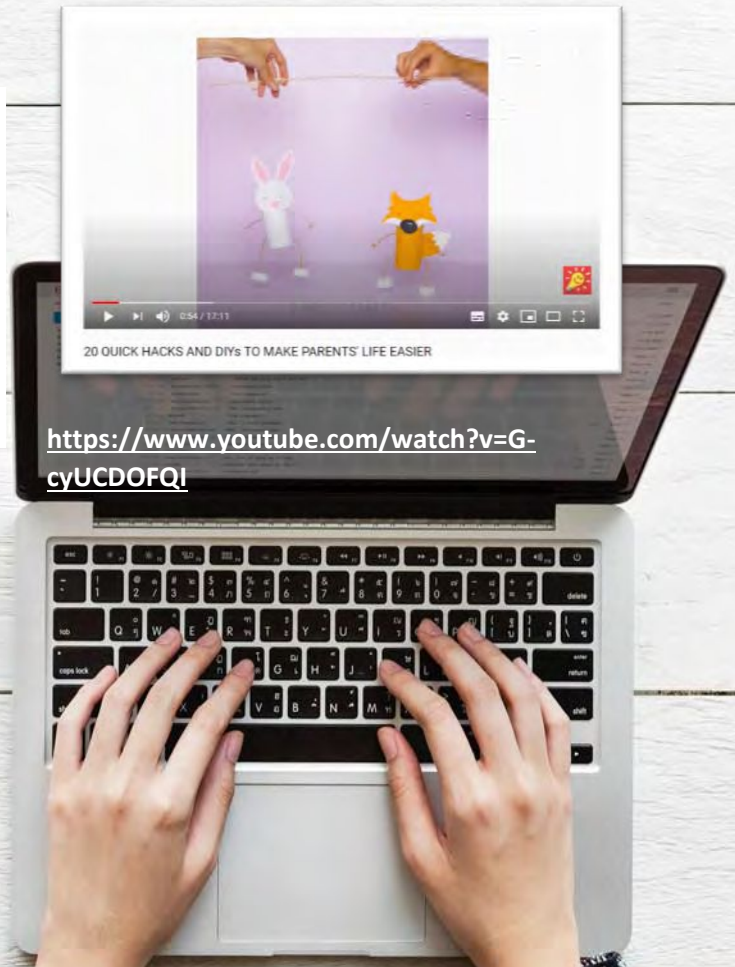
